- ❖ Nature hikes & other events

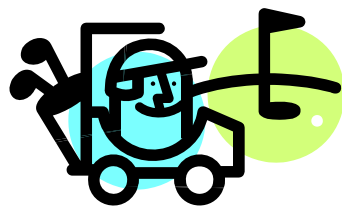
At Golden Ridge, not only will your child expand their golf skills, but they will also have an amazing time making new friends and increasing their athletic and interpersonal skills.

TYPICAL DAY AT GOLDEN RIDGE

3:45 p.m.	Snack
4:00 p.m.	Mini-Putt & other activities

Upon the conclusion of golf camp, campers and parents will have the opportunity to attend "graduation" where campers receive a Certificate of Completion.





GENERAL INFORMATION

CAMP STAFF

Camp Staff are carefully selected based on their experience working with children, strong leadership skills, golf skills, enthusiasm and sound judgement.

CAMPER DROP-OFF AND PICKUP

Children are to be dropped off and picked up in the clearly marked designated area. Parents are to ensure that campers are signed in and out each day on the provided sign-in/out sheets. Further, for maximum safety, parents must ensure that the designated camp supervisor is made aware of the camper's arrival and departure.

EMERGENCY INFORMATION

It is vital that all emergency contact information as well as doctor's contact information and a copy of the camper's health card are provided.

CAMPER'S AGES

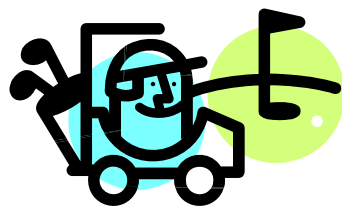
The camp is designed for maximum benefit to children from SK to Grade 9 and children are grouped according to age and skill.

CAMP HOURS

Camp hours are between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. Extended care is offered between 7:30 a.m. and 9 a.m. OR between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. at a cost of \$25 per week.

LUNCH AND SNACKS

Campers are required to bring their own lunch and snacks. Lunch and snacks should not require refrigeration and due to possible nut allergies among other campers, peanut butter, nuts and food containing nuts are not permitted.



WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

Please send the following with your child:

- ❖ Sunscreen and Hat
- ❖ Bug Spray
- ❖ Water Bottle
- ❖ Extra clothing
- ❖ Required medication

All items should be in a back pack and clearly labelled with your child's name.

CAMP FEES

- ❖ \$337 per week for Full Day camps.
\$277 for 4 days weeks with a statutory holiday.
- ❖ \$199 for a ½ day camp which is 9 a.m. to 12 noon or 1 p.m. to 4 p.m.
\$159 for 4 day weeks with a statutory holiday
- ❖ \$25 per week for extended care which is 7:30 a.m. to 9 a.m. OR 4 p.m. to 6 p.m.
\$50 per week for both sessions.
- ❖ A 10% discount is offered on basic camp fees for the 2nd and subsequent children registered, however this discount cannot be combined with any other coupons or offers.

Camp fees may be paid by credit card, debit, or cash. Payment must be made at time of registration.

REGISTRATION

Spaces for each camp are limited and are taken on a first-come first-serve basis. Registration forms should be completed for each child.

The Town of Richmond Hill and others sub contract their golf camps to Golden Ridge. However if you are registering with them, their forms, prices and policies apply.
